Marathon is currently inviting applications for a Camp Superintendent to join our growing team as the company transitions to mine construction and ultimately mine operations.

Job Description

Reporting to the Project VP, the Camp Superintendent is responsible for the delivery of support services such as transportation, accommodations, and Project site access. The incumbent will direct the coverage of the 300 person Camp Accommodations facility including the catering and cleaning and maintenance and ensure those areas are supervised in a safe and environmentally sensitive way as well as in a practical & cost effective manner.

This position is located at the Project site on rotation.

Accountabilities/Responsibilities:

- Ensure that effective Health, Safety and Environmental procedures, government regulations and Marathon Gold standard operating procedures (SOPs) are being implemented and followed.
- Perform Safety inspections of the relevant areas in conjunction with Health & Safety, Environment, and contractors.

- Manage the administration and coordination of activities involved in mobilization and demobilization of personnel to and from the mine site.
- Ensure a high level of safety awareness and compliance within the department by promoting Safe Production as our way of doing work.
- Prepare and monitor an annual operations, capital, and workforce budget.
- Manage the department and contractors’ transportation of personnel to and from the designated pick-up points and the mine site.
- Manage the contractor responsible for freight movement for the accommodations complex (i.e. furnishings, food, beverage, cleaning supplies etc.).
- Manage the operation of the camp site support systems such as potable water, firewater, electricity, heat, and waste disposal systems for the accommodation complex
- Manage the onsite accommodations to ensure that safe, clean, comfortable living quarters with high quality food and leisure activities.
- Provide process improvement recommendations that will enhance the overall business.
- Perform other related duties as assigned.

- 10 years’ experience related to camp, hotel or restaurant management.
- Experience in leadership roles is required.
- Experience in a remote work site is required.
