Once in production, it will be the largest gold mine in Atlantic Canada and a major employer in the province. Marathon is a public corporation (TSX:MOZ) headquartered in Toronto, Ontario with a regional office located in Grand Falls-Windsor, NL.

Essential Job Functions:

The Cook's Helper is responsible for assisting with all aspects of food handling, food preparation, and maintenance of a sanitary work environment in accordance with the Project mine site standards. In addition, responsibilities also include the observance of all aspects of the camp's COVID-19 Safety Plan that relate to food service.

This is a fixed term contract position based at the Project site on a 14/14 rotation.

Accountabilities:

- Assist in the daily preparation of meals for 100+ people as directed by the Cook.
- Participate in daily cleaning of kitchen and work area, including:
 - Equipment
 - Prep areas
 - Storage areas
 - Fridges and freezers
- Ensure all kitchen equipment is cleaned after use according to health and safety policies and procedures.
- Manage kitchen operations in accordance to health and safety standards.
- Participate in regulatory inspections of kitchen equipment and appliances and report required maintenance to the Cook.
- Stock refrigerators and storage units as required.
- Unload grocery orders and ensure proper storage and labeling.
- Participate in regular inventory counts, keep records of the quantities of food used, and aid in the ordering of necessary of food items.
- Serve on the food line, as required.
- Occasionally fill in the absence of the Cook when required.
- Perform other duties as assigned or directed by the Cook or Camp Manager.



Education:

- High School diploma or equivalent.
- Culinary Arts certificate, diploma or degree, Canadian Red Seal trade qualification would be an asset.
- License/Certification: Food Safe, SafeCheck, Food Handler or equivalent.
- Valid Emergency First Aid Certificate (Preferred).
- Valid Workplace Materials Information System Certificate (WHMIS).

- 5 years' experience in food preparation for large groups.
- Experience in a remote work setting and on shift/rotations preferred.

Skills and Knowledge:

- Ability to read and follow a recipe unsupervised.
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills.
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team.
- Strong organizational and time management skills.
- Ability to promote a positive safety work culture.
- Possess basic knowledge of dietary restrictions and common food allergies.
- Strong knowledge of cleaning equipment, food preparation, and general cleaning processes.
- Familiarity with kitchen equipment.
- Some advanced cooking skills.

- Understanding of various cooking methods, ingredients, equipment, and procedures.
- Ability to work in a fast-paced physically demanding environment, under pressure, perform repetitive tasks, handle heavy loads, pay attention to detail, and stand for extended periods of time.
