The Operator 3: Fuel Lube is a team member of the Mine department and is responsible for fueling and lubing of field mobile equipment and performing preventative maintenance in the shop. In addition, this role is responsible to perform minor repairs on equipment and assist other maintenance employees as required. This role must ensure work is performed in accordance with health, safety, and environmental and legislative requirements.

This position is located at the Project site, working on a 14 days in/14 days out rotation.

Accountabilities/Responsibilities:

- Be a courageous health, safety, and environment advocate, adhere to and promote health, safety and environmental standards, policies and procedures.
- Conduct field fueling and lubing of mobile equipment.
- Perform minor repairs on equipment.
- Perform various labour-related shop duties as required.
- Assist other maintenance employees as required.
- Use tools and equipment for routine and non-routine lubrication functions.
- Drain, fill, and clean reservoirs.
- Change filters and breathers on reservoirs.
- Label and tag reservoirs, equipment, inventory and delivery containers.
- Print and fulfil planned lubrication activities.
- Report any discrepancies or conditions that require corrective, predictive, or planned maintenance for production systems.
- Actively participate in orientation and training programs.
- Conduct inspections of equipment, tools site level risk assessment of the work area.
- Adhere to all company policies and procedures.
- Perform other duties as assigned.

Education and Experience Required:

- High School Diploma or equivalent.
- Minimum of 2 years' experience working in a fuel lube service role in a mining environment
- Experience operating an articulating dump truck
- Experience working in a remote industrial environment is preferred.

Skills and Knowledge:

- Strong knowledge of the OHS, mining, and construction regulations.
- Knowledge of health, safety, and environmental requirements in province of NL.
- Previous mechanical experience with heavy equipment, good organizational and prioritizing skills to aid in coordination of daily tasks.

- Experience with radio communication and protocols.
- Excellent communication (oral/written) skills required.
